

Minutes of the HF Contest Committee meeting held via Skype 24th October 2019 at 20.00

1. HF Contest Changes

As a result of discussion at the HF Contest Forum at the Convention, the following changes were agreed:

1.1. FT4 Contests

It was agreed to amend the rules as follows:

- 1.1.1. The scoring to be QSOs (1 point for each) x Grid Multipliers (1 for each large grid square worked).
- 1.1.2. Contacts with HQ stations will score 5 QSO points + 1 Grid Multiplier point.
- 1.1.3. This change will be introduced for the final pilot contest in November 2019 and for all contests in 2020

1.2. 2020 FT Contest Series

A series of 9 contests to be held on Mondays from 20.00 to 21.30 local time.

- 17th February
- 16th March
- 27th April
- 18th May
- 15th June
- 27th July
- 28th September
- 19th October
- 16th November

1.3. 80m CCs and Autumn Series

The following changes were agreed:

- 1.3.1. Single category for SSB in both power sections.
- 1.3.2. As a result of reports that the mandatory 2-minute quiet period before the start of the contest is being breached, it was agreed that a penalty of 5 QSOs be imposed on stations who are recorded as transmitting during this time.
- 1.3.3. The published contest dates for Autumn Series 2020 were amended as follows:
 - 5th October CW
 - 14th October Data
 - 2nd November Data
 - 11th November SSB



- 1.4. 40m QSO Parties delete from calendar
- 1.5. SSB Field Day change Low Power Assisted Portable to High Power Assisted Portable
- 1.6. IOTA Contest reinstate mandatory signal reports
- 1.7. Low Power Contest
 - 1.7.1. Replace 3W category with 5W
 - 1.7.2. Add 5W and 10W non-UK&CD categories (fixed or portable)
