

Minutes of the HF Contest Committee meeting held via Skype 11th September 2019 at 20:00

Apologies for absence were received from Ian G0FCT, Mike G7TWC and Stewart GW0ETF

- 1. Rule changes for the October FT4 Contest
 - 1.1. It was agreed to modify the rules for the next event as follows:
 - 1.1.1. The NA VHF contest format will be adopted i.e. the required exchange will be a four-character locator only i.e. no signal report or serial number.
 - 1.1.2. The contest period will be extended to 90 minutes.
 - 1.1.3. The recommended dial frequencies will be 3576, 3579, 3582 kHz thus avoiding established FT8 frequencies and providing additional bandwidth.
 - 1.1.4. Non-UK&CD entrants in both the 100w and 10w sections will be shown in separate tables. (It was agreed to re-present the results of the first FT4 contest to include these new sections).
 - 1.1.5. Non-UK&CD stations may work other non-UK&CD stations but will score double points for working stations situated in the UK&CD (apart from HQ stations).
 - 1.2. It was agreed that the rules would be subject to further review based on the experience of, and feedback from, entrants in the October event and the Convention.
- 2. HF Contests in 2020
 - 2.1. It was agreed to use the HF Contest session at the Convention to consult on potential changes i.e.
 - 2.1.1. How should we take forward FT4 in 2020?
 - 2.1.2. Should we change the Assisted/Unassisted sections in the 80m CC that were introduced in 2019?
 - 2.1.3. What should happen to the 40m QSO parties?
 - 2.1.4. SSB Field Day. Should we add a High-Power section?
 - 2.1.5. IOTA. Could the exchange be improved? Should we make signal reports compulsory once more?
